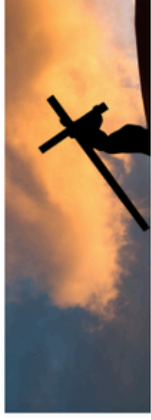

The King Who Comes in Humility

Palm Sunday draws us into a powerful tension, beginning with joyful cries of “Hosanna” as Jesus enters Jerusalem, and leading us into the solemn reality of His Passion. He comes not in power or grandeur, but in humility, revealing a kingship rooted in self-giving love. The readings remind us of the suffering servant who trusts in God, the cry of one who feels abandoned yet hopes, and Christ who emptied Himself, becoming obedient even to death on a cross. As we begin Holy Week, we are not just observers but participants—called to reflect on whether we follow Jesus only in moments of joy or also through suffering and sacrifice. May we carry our palms not only as signs of praise, but as a commitment to walk with Him faithfully toward the hope of the Resurrection. Hosanna in the highest.

El Rey que Viene con Humildad

El Domingo de Ramos nos introduce en una profunda tensión: comenzamos con los gritos de alegría de “¡Hosanna!” mientras Jesús entra en Jerusalén, y somos llevados al mismo tiempo a la solemnidad de su Pasión. Él no llega con poder ni grandeza, sino con humildad, revelando un reinado basado en el amor que se entrega. Las lecturas nos recuerdan al siervo sufriente que confía en Dios, al clamor de quien se siente abandonado pero mantiene la esperanza, y a Cristo que se despoja de sí mismo, haciéndose obediente hasta la muerte en la cruz. Al iniciar la Semana Santa, no somos solo espectadores, sino participantes, llamados a preguntarnos si seguimos a Jesús solo en la alegría o también en el sufrimiento y el sacrificio. Que llevemos nuestros ramos no solo como signo de alabanza, sino como compromiso de caminar con Él fielmente hacia la esperanza de la Resurrección. ¡Hosanna en el cielo!

O Rei que Vem com Humildade

O Domingo de Ramos nos introduz em uma profunda tensão: começamos com os gritos de alegria de “Hosana!” quando Jesus entra em Jerusalém, e ao mesmo tempo somos conduzidos à solenidade de sua Paixão. Ele não chega com poder ou grandeza, mas com humildade, revelando um reinado fundamentado no amor que se entrega. As leituras nos recordam o servo sofredor que confia em Deus, o clamor de quem se sente abandonado, mas ainda espera, e Cristo que se esvaziou, tornando-se obediente até a morte de cruz. Ao iniciarmos a Semana Santa, não somos apenas espectadores, mas participantes, chamados a refletir se seguimos Jesus somente nos momentos de alegria ou também no sofrimento e no sacrifício. Que levemos nossos ramos não apenas como sinal de louvor, mas como compromisso de caminhar com Ele fielmente rumo à esperança da Ressurreição. Hosana nas alturas!

HOLY WEEK

Did you know that this week is the most important one in the whole year? Holy Week has Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday. On these days we remember and celebrate the most important things that Jesus did before His resurrection on Easter Sunday.

On Holy Thursday Jesus said the first Mass and made his apostles the first priests. Go to Mass on Thursday if you can, and think about what Jesus did- He made bread and wine into Himself so that He could still be with us after He went back into Heaven.

On Good Friday Jesus suffered terribly and then died on the cross because of our sins. He offered up His life, even though He had never sinned, so that all of us could go to Heaven. That's why we call it "Good" Friday. Can you offer some sacrifice to Jesus in return for what He did for you?

On Holy Saturday Jesus' body was in the tomb. His friends were all shocked by what had happened and were afraid and sad. They did not remember what was going to happen next ... Do you remember what happened after Holy Saturday?

What did Jesus do on the cross?

On Good Friday JESUS was taken before King HEROD and the governor, PILATE. Even though He had not committed any crime He was scourged and condemned to die on the CROSS. He CARRIED the cross as far as He could up CALVARY hill, but when He got too weak a man named SIMON of CYRENE was forced to help Him. On the way He met His mother, MARY, who WEPT at seeing her Son in such pain. A woman named VERONICA wiped the blood and sweat from His face with a cloth. At the top of the HILL Jesus was thrown onto the cross and His HANDS and FEET were fastened to it with NAILS. They raised the cross, where Jesus hung for three hours before He DIED. He did all this to SAVE us from Hell. At the cross were JOHN, Mary MAGDALENE, His mother, and some other women. At the moment He died the curtain of the old Temple was TORN in half. When His body was taken down from the cross JOSEPH of Arimathea and NICODEMUS BURIED Him in a new TOMB and rolled a HEAVY STONE in front of the door.
