Readings: 1 Sam 16:1b, 6-7, 10-13a | Ps 23:1-3a, 3b-4, 5, 6 | Eph 5:8-14 | Jn 9:1-49

Living Water That Satisfies

This Sunday's readings invite us to reflect on how God sees and how we are called to see. When Samuel searches for the next king, the Lord reminds him that while people look at appearances, God looks into the heart, choosing David for what others could not see. In the Gospel, Jesus heals the man born blind, revealing that true sight is not only physical but spiritual—the ability to recognize God at work. While the man grows in faith and comes to believe in Jesus, those who think they see remain blind to the truth. St. Paul reminds us that we were once in darkness, but in Christ we are called to live as children of light. As we continue our Lenten journey, we ask the Lord to open our eyes, transform our hearts, and help us walk faithfully in His light.

Agua Viva que Sacia

Las lecturas de este domingo nos invitan a reflexionar sobre cómo ve Dios y cómo estamos llamados a ver nosotros. Cuando Samuel busca al próximo rey, el Señor le recuerda que mientras las personas miran las apariencias, Dios mira el corazón, eligiendo a David por lo que otros no podían ver. En el Evangelio, Jesús sana al hombre que nació ciego, revelando que la verdadera vista no es solo física sino también espiritual: la capacidad de reconocer a Dios actuando en nuestra vida. Mientras el hombre crece en la fe y llega a creer en Jesús, quienes piensan que ven permanecen ciegos ante la verdad. San Pablo nos recuerda que antes vivíamos en la oscuridad, pero en Cristo estamos llamados a vivir como hijos de la luz. Al continuar nuestro camino de Cuaresma, pidamos al Señor que abra nuestros ojos, transforme nuestro corazón y nos ayude a caminar fielmente en su luz.


Água Viva que Sacia


