FROM THE PASTOR'S OFFICE

Readings: Sir 15:15-20 | Ps 119:1-2, 4-5, 17-18, 33-34 | 1 Cor 2:6-10 | Mt 5:17-37

The Path to True Freedom

Today's readings invite us to reflect on the profound gift of freedom and the seriousness of our response to God's law. Sirach reminds us that God places before us life and death and allows us to choose; He does not command the impossible, nor does He force our obedience. The psalmist proclaims that those who walk in the law of the Lord are blessed, discovering that God's commandments are not burdens but a path to wisdom and joy. St. Paul speaks of a deeper wisdom—God's own wisdom—revealed through the Spirit to those who love Him. In the Gospel, Jesus fulfills the law by leading us beyond external observance to interior transformation. He calls us to examine not only our actions but our anger, our desires, our words, and our integrity. The Lord desires hearts aligned with His own, and through His grace, He strengthens us to choose the path that leads to life, holiness, and peace.

El Camino de la Verdadera Libertad

Las lecturas de hoy nos invitan a reflexionar sobre el gran don de la libertad y la seriedad de nuestra respuesta a la ley de Dios. El libro del Sirácide nos recuerda que el Señor pone delante de nosotros la vida y la muerte y nos permite elegir; no nos impone lo imposible ni nos obliga a obedecer. El salmista proclama que dichosos los que caminan en la ley del Señor, descubriendo que sus mandamientos no son una carga, sino un camino de sabiduría y alegría. San Pablo habla de una sabiduría más profunda —la sabiduría misma de Dios— revelada por el Espíritu a quienes lo aman. En el Evangelio, Jesús no elimina la ley, sino que la lleva a su plenitud, invitándonos a ir más allá del cumplimiento externo hacia una verdadera conversión del corazón. El Señor quiere un corazón coherente, limpio en sus intenciones y fiel en sus palabras, y con su gracia nos fortalece para elegir el camino que conduce a la vida, la santidad y la paz.

O Caminho da Verdadeira Liberdade

As leituras de hoje nos convidam a refletir sobre o grande dom da liberdade e a seriedade da nossa resposta à lei de Deus. O livro do Eclesiástico nos lembra que o Senhor coloca diante de nós a vida e a morte e nos permite escolher; Ele não nos impõe o impossível nem nos obriga a obedecer. O salmista proclama que felizes são aqueles que caminham na lei do Senhor, descobrindo que seus mandamentos não são um peso, mas um caminho de sabedoria e alegria. São Paulo fala de uma sabedoria mais profunda — a própria sabedoria de Deus — revelada pelo Espírito àqueles que O amam. No Evangelho, Jesus não elimina a lei, mas a leva à plenitude, convidando-nos a ir além do cumprimento externo para uma verdadeira conversão do coração. O Senhor deseja um coração íntegro, puro nas intenções e fiel nas palavras, e com a sua graça nos fortalece para escolher o caminho que conduz à vida, à santidade e à paz.

ASH WEDNESDAY

This coming Wednesday is Ash Wednesday, which is the first day of Lent. Lent is a special time in which we prepare to celebrate Jesus' death and resurrection on Good Friday and Easter Sunday.


Lent is a time of repentance. We make sacrifices and try to improve our lives to become more like Jesus. Jesus never sinned but He gave up His life to pay for our sins. That is why we make sacrifices-out of love for God and to make up for our sins. We offer our sacrifices to God the Father, just as Jesus on the cross offered up His life to God the Father.

On Ash Wednesday if you go to Mass you can receive ashes on your forehead. The ashes are a sign of repentance. They remind us that without God we are nothing and that someday we will die and be buried. But they can also remind us that if we do have God living in us, after we die we will rise from the dead, just as Jesus did on Easter, after He died on the cross.


