Living Water That Satisfies

On this Third Sunday of Lent, the Church's readings invite us to reflect on our deep spiritual thirst and God's faithful response to it. In Exodus, the Israelites doubt in the desert, yet God brings forth water from the rock; in Psalm 95, we are urged not to harden our hearts but to trust in the Lord. St. Paul reminds us in Romans that our hope does not disappoint because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit. In the Gospel, Jesus offers the Samaritan woman living water that truly satisfies, transforming her into a joyful witness. As we continue our Lenten journey, may we recognize our own thirst for God and allow Christ to renew us with His grace and love.


Agua Viva que Sacia

En este Tercer Domingo de Cuaresma, la Iglesia nos invita a reflexionar sobre nuestra sed espiritual y la respuesta fiel de Dios. En el libro del Éxodo, el pueblo duda en el desierto, pero el Señor hace brotar agua de la roca; en el Salmo 95 se nos exhorta a no endurecer el corazón, sino a confiar en Él. San Pablo nos recuerda en Romanos que la esperanza no defrauda, porque el amor de Dios ha sido derramado en nuestros corazones por el Espíritu Santo. En el Evangelio, Jesús ofrece a la samaritana el agua viva que sacia para siempre y transforma su vida. 

In today's first reading, the Israelites in the desert are thirsty and ask Moses for water. So God tells him to strike a big rock with his staff and water comes out. In the Gospel reading, Jesus tells the Samaritan woman that He can give her living water so that she will never be thirsty.



Water is a symbol of life. In the first story the people in the desert would have died if they didn't get water. Now Jesus gives us His life, which is grace. We receive it especially in Holy Communion. This is the living water that He is talking about.

Our souls need His grace to stay alive.

When you have a drink of water, think about how your body needs water to stay alive, and how your soul needs God's grace. Saying a prayer is kind of like giving your soul a little drink!
