Readings: Acts 10:34a, 37-43 | Ps 118:1-2, 16-17, 22-23 | 1 Cor 5:6b-8 | Jn 20:1-9

Celebrating the Miracle of the Resurrection

Jesus is risen. Alleluia! This Easter Sunday, the readings come together to proclaim the beautiful truth of the Resurrection. In the Gospel, we see the empty tomb and the first stirrings of faith in the hearts of the disciples. In Acts, Peter boldly testifies that Jesus, who was crucified, has been raised and now brings forgiveness and new life to all who believe. St. Paul reminds us to cast out the old and live as a new creation, while the Psalm rejoices: "This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad." Together, these readings invite us to embrace the wonder of this miracle and to live in the joy and hope of Christ's victory over death.

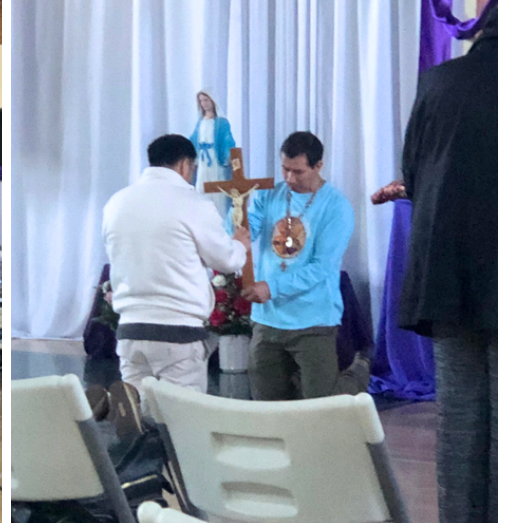

Today is the biggest feast of the year!

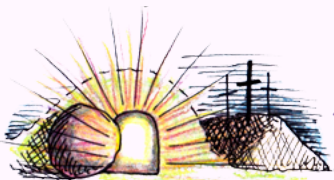
Jesus rose from the dead on the first Easter Sunday. By rising from the dead, He showed that He was God and that everything He had said was true. It showed

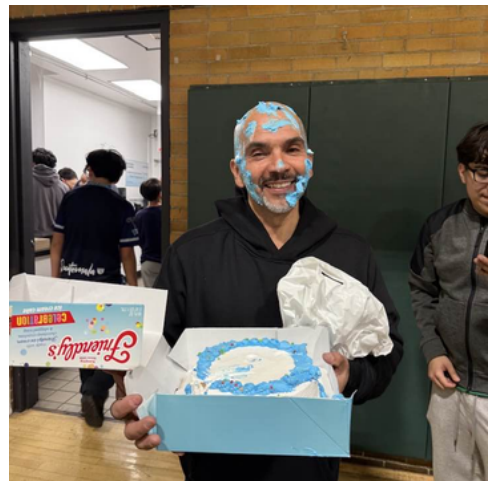
